EXIST-Women





It focuses on the development of their entrepreneurial personalities and the further refinement of their startup ideas. Following the motto "LiveYourPassion," the program provides women with personalized (financial) support for entrepreneurship.

If you wish to advance your entrepreneurial goals while receiving both **mental** and **financial** support, we are delighted to introduce our EXIST-Women scholarship program. This program offers you the opportunity to manifest your entrepreneurial visions and realize your dreams.

Applications are now open. Please send us a **one-minute pitch video** to the following email address: tugz@ovgu.de. We are interested in knowing: **Who are you? What are your plans? What do you want to achieve?** With the criteria provided, you can focus your selfie on the most important content.

In this round, we can award a total of **ten scholarships**. We will notify you as soon as possible whether your application was successful and what the next steps are. 
Who is EXIST-Women aiming at?


What are my obligations as a participant?





What about the application and selection process?



Your application is a approximately one-minute **selfie video** that you send to us (<u>tugz@ovgu.de</u>). We have created a criteria catalog for the selection process. A jury of mentors and experts from our university will review and evaluate your application. After that, you will be notified whether we can offer you one of the ten scholarships in the first round.
